Minnesotans who want to catch some quality family time are encouraged to take advantage of Take-A-Kid Fishing weekend, which is June 5-7. Minnesota residents 18 and older can fish for free during these days when they accompany an angler younger than 16.

Licenses are required if you are 16 or older fishing by yourself.

All Anglers are responsible for knowing the regulations for fishing, quantities, size limits, etc. Understand the rules regarding disposing of fish parts.
